Stan Simon & Eva Kolodziejewski - Stan and Eva are the grandchildren of Stanislaw and Luba Kolodziejewski. Stanislaw risked his own life during World War II to save the lives of Luba Kopur and her daughter Krystyna from the Warsaw Ghetto. Because of Stanislaw's humanity and bravery, Luba and Krystyna remained in hiding throughout the war and survived. Stanislaw and Luba later married and had a son, Mark.

Josh Gerstein, Francine Gerstein, and Alena Drmolová - Josh and Francine Gerstein are the children of Ben Gerstein who, along with his sister, mother and father and other relatives were hidden during the War and whose lives were saved through the heroic acts of Bohuslav and Olga Čepek and their eldest daughter Evzenie. Alena Drmolová is their granddaughter.

Mark Mulroney - Vice-Chair, Global Banking & Markets, Scotiabank. Mark is the son of the late Honourable Brian Mulroney who served as the 18th Prime Minister of Canada from 1984 to 1993.

Cantor David Rosen - Senior Cantor and Music Director of Holy Blossom Temple.
